IIU investigates Criminal Code allegations against Brandon Police Service

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba (IIU) is investigating allegations of potential Criminal Code offences by members of the Brandon Police Service (BPS).

On July 5, 2017, the IIU was notified of a complaint involving members of the Brandon Police Service, alleging conduct and criminal code offences between February and June 2017. As one of the allegations in this matter may involve a prescribed offence under the *Police Services Act* (obstruct justice), an IIU investigation is mandatory.

This matter is at the earliest stages of investigation; no further comment will be made until the investigation is complete.
