IIU investigating alleged inappropriate conduct by RCMP officer

Manitoba's Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) is investigating an incident at a Winnipeg hotel that involves allegations of lewd conduct by an RCMP officer.

On December 5, 2017, the IIU was notified by RCMP "D" Division that it had received a complaint about the inappropriate conduct of a female officer while she was attending a conference in Winnipeg. It was alleged that on November 30th, during a social gathering at a hotel and lounge, the subject officer committed a number of instances of inappropriate sexual touching. Following a review of the circumstances of the complaints, the IIU civilian director has determined it is in the public interest for the agency to conduct an independent investigation.

The IIU investigates all serious incidents involving police officers in Manitoba, whether occurring on or off duty. For more information, visit www.iiumanitoba.ca
