IIU investigating officer-involved shooting

The Independent Investigation Unit (IIU) is investigating an officer-involved shooting that occurred last night in Winnipeg.

On March 3, 2019 IIU was notified by the Winnipeg Police Service of an incident involving a call for service for a break and enter in progress and an officer discharging a firearm on McGee Street. A male was transported to Health Sciences Centre and at this time remains in critical condition.

A team of IIU investigators was immediately deployed to the scene and the investigation commenced.

As an injury caused by the discharge of a firearm is defined as a serious injury under IIU regulations, IIU is mandated to investigate.

The investigation is ongoing so no further details will be provided at this time.
