## IIU investigating injuries during arrest on Sagkeeng First Nation

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba is investigating an incident in which an RCMP firearm was discharged during an arrest, resulting in injury to a male subject.

According to the "D" Division RCMP notification, on February 4, 2017 at approximately 4:00 a.m., officers executed a search warrant for firearms and controlled substances at a residence on Sagkeeng First Nation. During the course of executing the search warrant, an officer fired one round from a firearm, discharging a beanbag round and striking a male in the abdomen.

The male sustained bruising to the abdomen and a cut to his right hand. Any injury caused by discharge of a firearm is deemed a serious injury under IIU regulations; therefore, an investigation by the IIU is mandatory.
