IIU investigating conduct of member of Dakota Ojibway Police Service

The Independent Investigation Unit of Manitoba (IIU) is looking into allegations of inappropriate conduct by a member of the Dakota Ojibway Police Service (DOPS).

The IIU was notified of a series of incidents involving the member and the IIU civilian director determined it is in the public interest for the IIU to investigate.

The matter is at the earliest stages of investigation and, as such, facts and circumstances continue to be gathered and assessed. No further comment will be made until the investigation is complete.
